The 2020 Census count impacts the federal funds that communities receive each year for programs and services that are critical for schools, students, and younger children, families and residents such as:

- Special education, Head Start, after-school programs, and classroom technology.
- Food assistance, including free and reduced-price school lunches.
- Maternal and child health programs.
- Temporary Assistance for Needed Families (TANF)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
- Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers
- Roads and Bridges
- Parks, playgrounds, recreational facilities
- Community development block grants
